

This present writing declares to all persons that Wee John Greene James Greene and Thomas Greene Inhabitants of the Towne of Warwick in the Collony of Road Island and Providence Plantations being the sons of Mr John Greene , formerly Inhabitant of the said Towne of Warwick who about the time of his death made a will which bears date the eighth day of December 1658 and in his said will did bequeath to each of us certain portions of land as the said will doth more at large set forth, but doth not express Heirs and Assigns therein, Wee the said John Greene, James Greene and Thomas Greene, certainly knowing that is was an honored father aforesaid his true intent and meanings in his said will that each parsell of land therein mentioned to be granted to each or either of us should be remain as ... to each or either of the Heirs or Assigns and therefore for the preventing of future trouble and discord that might arise thereby to Heirs and successors through a misunderstanding. We the said John Greene James Greene and Thomas Greene do ... and Each to other joyntly and ... in a bond of thousand Pounds Sterling that neither of us, Heirs or Assigns shall molest each other in the peacable enjoymnt of these lands bequeathed to either of us in said fathers will according to the true intent and meaning by so declared as aforesaid and to the performance hereof doo bind us our Heirs Executors, Administrators jointly and severally as we witness hands and seals this 16th of January 1682.


